

Pop Culture and Entertainment Gingerbread Disguise Project Ideas

1. Harry Potter

- **Materials**: Black felt (robe), red and yellow paper (scarf), pipe cleaner (glasses), marker (wand).
- Steps:
- 1. Cover the gingerbread in black felt for the robe.
- 2. Wrap a red and yellow striped scarf around the neck area.
- 3. Create glasses from pipe cleaners and draw a wand with a marker.

15. Superman

- Materials: Blue felt (body), red paper (cape), yellow paper (chest emblem).

16. The Hulk

- Materials: Yellow felt (body), red felt (shirt), black marker.
- Steps:
- 1. Cover the gingerbread in yellow felt for Pooh's fur.
- 2. Add a red-felt shirt over the top.
- 3. Draw a simple face with a black marker.

26. Eeyore

- Materials: Blue paper (body), pink ribbon (tail), googly eyes.
- Steps:

- 1. Cover the gingerbread in blue paper.
- 2. Add a small pink ribbon tied to the tail.
- 3. Attach googly eyes for an adorable look.

27. Snoopy

- Materials: White felt (body), black felt (ears and spots), red paper (collar).
- Steps:
- 1. Wrap the body in white felt.
- 2. Add black felt ears and a spot on the back.
- 3. Create a red paper collar around the neck.

28. Garfield

- Materials: Orange paper (body), black marker (stripes), googly eyes.
- Steps:
- 1. Wrap the body in orange paper.
- 2. Draw Garfield's signature black stripes and face with a marker.
- 3. Attach googly eyes.

29. Simba

- Materials: Yellow felt (body), orange paper (mane), black marker.
- Steps:

- 1. Cover the body in yellow felt.
- 2. Cut and attach an orange mane around the head.
- 3. Draw a lion face with a marker.

30. Dory (Finding Nemo)

- Materials: Blue and yellow paper, googly eyes, glitter.
- Steps:
- 1. Wrap the body in blue paper and add yellow fins.
- 2. Attach googly eyes to the face.
- 3. Use glitter to add a shimmering underwater effect.

31. Tom (Tom & Jerry)

- Materials: Gray felt (fur), pink paper (ears), black marker (whiskers).
- Steps:
- 1. Cover the gingerbread with gray felt for Tom's fur.
- 2. Cut pink paper for the inner ears and attach them to the head.
- 3. Use a black marker to draw the face and whiskers.

32. Jerry (Tom & Jerry)

- Materials: Brown felt (body), yellow paper (cheese), black marker.

- 2. Cut out a triangle of yellow paper and add holes to resemble cheese.
- 3. Attach the cheese to one hand and draw Jerry's cheeky grin.

33. Bugs Bunny

- Materials: Gray felt (body), pink paper (ears), orange paper (carrot).

- 1. Cover the body with gray felt.
- 2. Make long ears from gray felt and pink paper, then attach them.
- 3. Create a carrot from orange and green paper and place it in Bugs' hand.

34. Tweety Bird

- Materials: Yellow felt (body), orange paper (feet and beak), googly eyes.
- Steps:
- 1. Wrap the gingerbread in yellow felt for Tweety's feathers.
- 2. Add orange paper for the feet and a small triangular beak.
- 3. Attach googly eyes and draw a cute expression.

35. Scooby-Doo

- Materials: Brown felt (fur), teal felt (collar), yellow paper (tag).
- Steps:

- 1. Cover the gingerbread with brown felt.
- 2. Add a teal felt collar around the neck and a yellow paper tag with "SD."
- 3. Draw Scooby's face with a marker, including his big nose.

36. Fred Flintstone

- Materials: Orange paper (tunic), black paper (spots), blue ribbon (tie).
