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## 5. Think Long-Term

## How to Write an SK Project Proposal? (Especially for Education Projects)

Got an awesome idea but don't know how to start your SK project proposal for education or any other cause? Chill, we got you! Writing an SK project proposal doesn't have to be scary. Just follow this simple outline to get your idea approved



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and rolling:

## 1. Project Title

Keep it short but catchy. Example: “Backpack Boost: School Supplies for All”

## 2. Project Description

Explain what your project is all about. Is it an SK project for education? A clean-up drive? A mental health seminar? Just tell the story behind your idea in simple words.

## 3. Objectives

What do you want to achieve? Example: “Help 100 students get school supplies” or “Teach basic coding to 30 youth in our barangay.”

## 4. Target Beneficiaries

Who will benefit from this? Students, out-of-school youth, the whole barangay? Be clear and specific.

## 5. Timeline

When will you do it? Make a simple calendar or schedule.

## 6. Budget

List all your expected expenses — like materials, snacks, or transportation. Keep it realistic and detailed.

## 7. Team & Volunteers

Who's helping — SK members, youth volunteers, or even teachers and parents.

## 8. Expected Outcome



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How will it help the community? This shows your idea has impact. Bonus tip: Connect it to ongoing SK activities or goals of Sangguniang Kabataan (SK project ideas).
